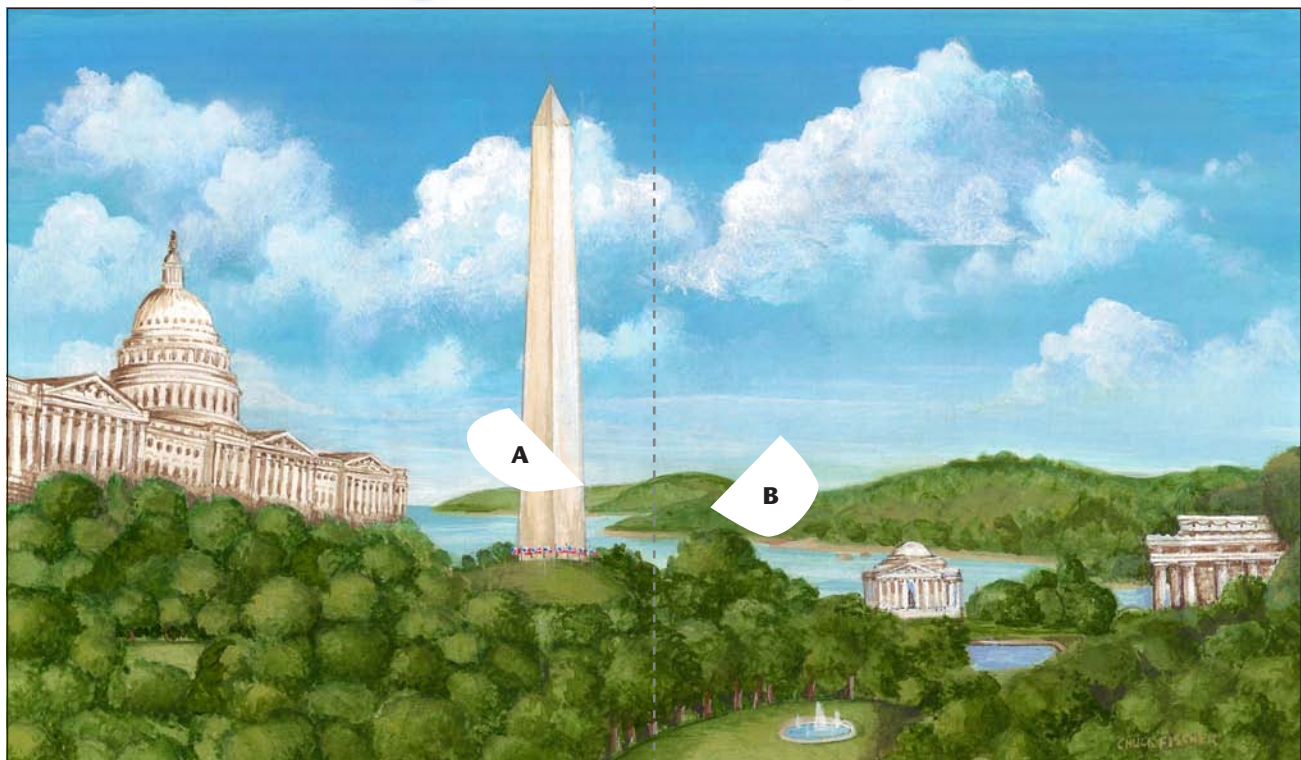
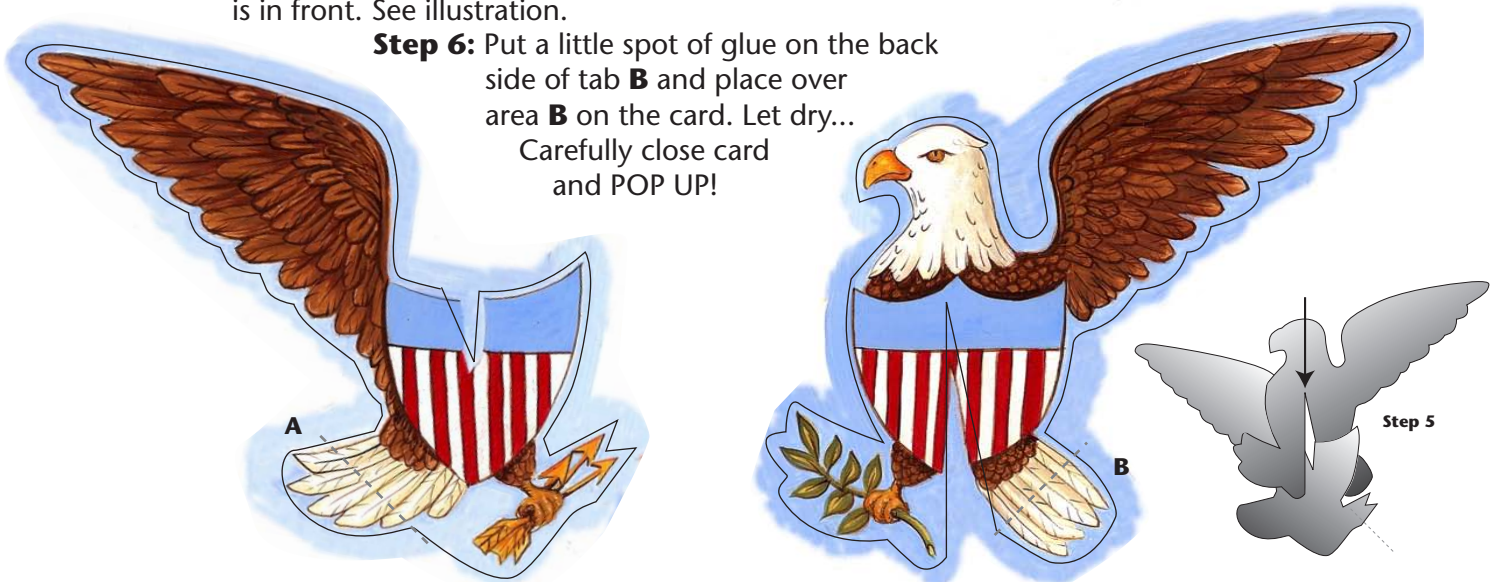


Make Your Own American Eagle Pop-Up!

- Step 1:** Use the rounded end of a paper clip to “score” (press along) the dotted lines. -----
Score the lines on both eagle pieces AND down the center of the card itself.
- Step 2:** Carefully cut out the pop up pieces and card along the black lines, even the “v” shape up into the eagle pieces. _____
- Step 3:** Bend the tabs (feather tails) back and forth to loosen them. Fold the card back and forth too!
- Step 4:** Put a small amount of white glue on the back of Tab **A** and place over the area marked **A** on the card. Let dry...
- Step 5:** Slide the Eagle half with the head down into the **A** half. Make sure the head of the eagle is in front. See illustration.

Step 6: Put a little spot of glue on the back side of tab **B** and place over area **B** on the card. Let dry...
Carefully close card and POP UP!
