SIL provides access to thousands of Ebooks from multiple sources, and all are linked through the Library's catalog, SIRIS. Each Ebook source has a unique interface for viewing and downloading books, which are noted below. Contact your branch librarian for more information and training.

Adobe Digital Editions is a Digital Rights Management (DRM) software that tracks the time allowed to view the book and removes access to the book when the time has expired. To download Adobe Digital Editions for your Smithsonian PC you will need to **contact OCIO** to install it (34000 or ociohelpdesk@si.edu).
